• (Referenced eight times more than the Lord's initial coming. It is alluded to more than 300 times in the New Testament.)

Matthew 24:37 - 39

"For the coming of the Son of Man will be just like the days of Noah, for as in these days before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark and they did not understand until the flood came and took them all away, so will the coming of the Son of Man be."

Acts 1:4-11

"On one occasion, while he was speaking to them, he gave them this command: Do not leave Jerusalem, but wait for the gift my Father promised, which you have heard me speak about For John baptized you with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit. Then they gathered around him and asked him, Lord are at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel? He said to them: it is not for you to know the times or periods the Father has set by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the farthest parts of the earth. After he had said this, while they were watching, he was lifted up and a cloud hid him from their sight. As they were still staring into the sky while he was going, suddenly two men in white clothing stood near them and said, Men of Galilee, why do you stand here looking up to the sky? This same Jesus who has been taken up from you will come back in the same way you saw him go into heaven."
