There is a difference between being judgmental and being descriptive.

John 3:16-17

"For God so loved the world that he gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. ¹⁷ For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn (judge) the world, but to save the world through him."
