#### **Jesus Waited**

#### John 11:5-7

"Now Jesus loved Martha and her sister and Lazarus. <sup>6</sup> So when He heard that Lazarus was sick, He stayed where He was two more days, <sup>7</sup> and then He said to His disciples, "Let us go back to Judea."

## John 11:4

"When He heard this, Jesus said, "This sickness will not end in death. No, it is for God's glory so that God's Son may be glorified through it."

# Why did Jesus wait?

- 1) To give the Father glory
- 2) To show that the Father doesn't live on my schedule.

We need to trust that the Father is able. Part of that trusting is leaving the timing up to Him.
